General Cat Information

Litter box training: SSCFOA cannot guarantee that any cat you adopt will be litter box trained, and even cats that are litter box trained are likely to have a few accidents within the first few days at a new home. It takes time for an animal to adjust to a new home. When bringing home your new cat, it is best to keep the cat confined in one room with its litter box for the first day or two.

Scratching post or carpets: Scratching is a normal behavior that allows your cat to condition its claws as it marks territory. It also provides an opportunity for a nice stretch. To prevent destructive scratching, trim your cat's nails regularly and provide a scratching post. Observe your new cat to see if it is a vertical or horizontal scratcher; this will help in making the decision on the type of scratching device that works best for your new cat.
